#### **Mary Potter House:**

Last week we informed the staff at Mary Potter House that Calvary will cease operating the service on the 30th June 2022. The decision to cease providing centre based day care and social support was made by the Local Health District late last year in response to the changes in funding for the remaining 12 months of the Commonwealth Home Support Program (CHSP) - which funds Mary Potter House.

Calvary has operated a day centre for close to 35 years and has forged an exceptional reputation in our community for providing compassionate and evidenced based care to some of our communities most vulnerable. The dedication, commitment and pride that the Mary Potter team have shown in delivering their service has been exceptional and I am personally and professionally very proud of what the team have delivered to our community during those 35 years.

I understand the closure of Mary Potter House will be upsetting to a number of you who have been part of this wonderful service over the years.

#### **Renovations**:

Below are the projects commencing/planned/completed:

- o Block-out blinds ordered and will be installed on the veranda where RAT is currently undertaken.
- o Upgrade of our paging system.
- o Replacement of automated watering system for gardens.
- o Education Room, Ground Floor and Conference Centre blinds installed.
- o Merging of rear gardens across Cottage Gardens where Community Palliative Care Teams are housed: Plan to be developed to amalgamate the rear gardens of cottages nos: 40, 42, 44 and 46 with paved seating areas, increase green footprint and pedestrian access to main hospital.

Refurbishment of our Palliative Care Ward is progressing well, , the scope has included the patient/family tea room, west wing balconies, Multi-faith room, quiet room tutorial room.
